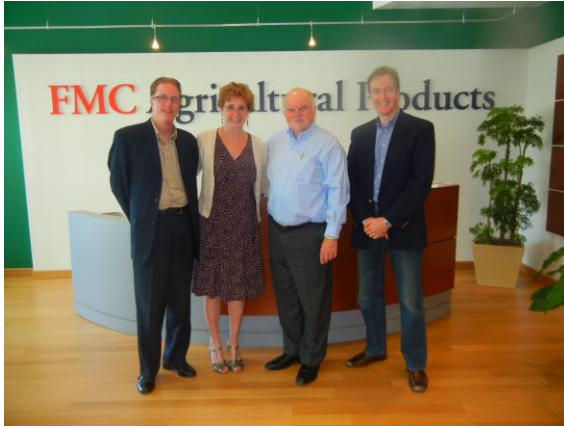


## Gianessi Presents to Two Large Audiences at FMC
