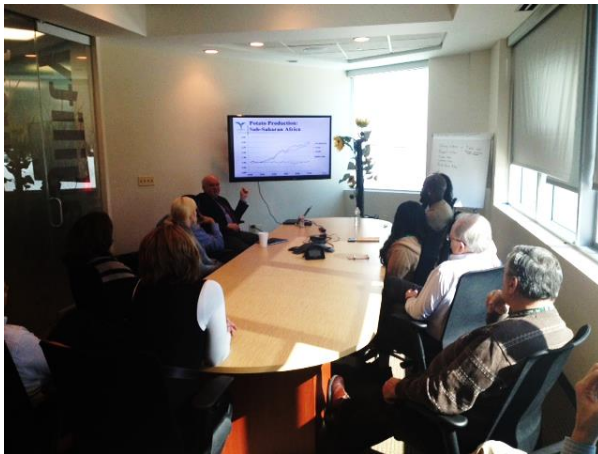


Bray and Gianessi Visit Nufarm
